In my opinion the callers voice was very similar to the male caller that gave the call to 2867 Ohio on 17 Aug 70. At that time he gave his address as 2865 Ohio. No car was sent to 2231 Community Plaza as the call could not be verified to my satisfaction per standard Operating Procedure.

Jack Swanson, Jerry Volcek, Robert Pfeffer, and Officer Tony Mohatt, tried to apprehend PEAK, Duane Christopher, Megro/male, 16 yrs. of age, in regards to the bombing death of Officer MILMRD. We checked the North 24th Street area with negative results and also went to 3528 North 29th Street, the home of FEAK, Frank Sr. and was notified that he was not at this address by Lgt. Pitman Formall. Egt. Formall stated that he had checked the house and he was positive that the PEAKS were not at this address. At 2230, armed with a search warrant issued by Judge Simon A. Simon after having reason to believe that David RICE, Militant to the City of Cmaha, may possibly be connected with the bombing death of Officer MINLAD, and could possibly have emplosives stored at his home, we checked the RICE residence at 2916 Parker St. and in so doing found in the basement hidden under a wooden door, a case of dynamite, two and one half inches (2'; ) in diameter. We also found emplosive caps, and wires hidden behind the radio in the front room of the RICE residence, also three rifles and a pistol were confisicated and sizable amount of ammunitic ms also found at this address. Refer to supplementary reports by Sgt. Swanson, and also Property Report by Officers Steimer and Howard as to the evidence recovered at the RICE home. At 9004 23 Aug 70, after advising the following person of his Constitutional Rights as stated in the Marinda Decision and the Rights Advisory Form being completed, and after being so advised of his rights, I questioned the following person of his activities near the RICE home at the time that it was searched by the reporting officers. WOODS, Ethan (MAN) 20, Neg/male, (DOD) 7 Jan 50, 2040 North 30th Ave, married one child, employed by the City of Omaha as a tree trimmer. WOODS stated that he and Michael RICE, a brother of David RICE, were going to visit David RICE'S home at 2916 Parker Street, and when they got there found the front door open and the television set on. He stated that about a week ago RICE'S house had been burglarized and they thought perhaps it had been burglarized again this evening. He said he and Michael RICE hollered in the front door to see if DAVID was home and when they received no response they checked the side door on Arrest or Juv. The following sta tement is given by JERKS, John Daniel, Negro M ale 42, who lives at 2904 Lothrop Str., 0 maha, Nebr., at P olice Headquarters, 0 maha, Nebraska, on 22 August 1 970 at 0935; to Officer Arnold DAILEY and Sgt. Robert Pfeffer; statement taken directly on typewriter by Sgt. Robert P feffer.

- Q. Mr. JERKS, are you acquainted with Duane C. PEA KS and his brother Donald PESKS?
- A. Yes, they both used to stay with me.
- Q. When is the last time that you had seen the PEAK brothers? A. Yesterday, Friday, 21 August 1970, when they visited the house next door to me at 2906 Lothrop.
- Q. Did you see the PEAK brothers last Sunday, 16 August 1970? A. Yes, I did, they were in the neighborhood visiting the NORRIS's at 2906 Lothrop Str.
- Q. Was there anything different about them, that you noticed? A. Yes, Duane had a suitcase, that I never see n him had before.
- Q. Can you describe the suitcase? A: Well, it was greyish in color, about medium size,
- Q. Why was this difference you seeing Duane P EAK with a suitcase? A. Well, I've never see n him with one before, when he stayed with us the only clothes he had he carried on his arm.
- Mr. JERKS, we have several types of suitcases here, can you pick out the le that closely resembles the one carried by Duane PEAK?

  A. Yes, that big one, (refering to the two suiter type), thats the same king that Duane Peak had, just about the same color, it appeared to be a new one.
- Q. Was there anything else differents, about the suitcase?
  A. Well, the way he carried it, it seemed like it was heady, too heavy for clothes, he was carrying it very careful. He carried the suitcase over NORRIS's house.
- Q. Was his brother Donald P eak with him when he went to the NORRIS house or apartment?
  A. No, he came over my house later, and asked if Duane was there, I told him that he was over NORRIS's.
- Q. Did you see either Dua ne or Donald PEAK leave the NOTRIS house with the suitcase?
- A. Yes, in the evening about 2100 or 2000, When Donald PEAK came to my house looking for Duane, I told him he was over NORRIS's, Donald went to the NORRIS' and about 15 minutes later both came out of the NORRIS's with Duane PEAK carrying the suitcase, and they got into a white car, with their sister Theresa PEAK and her boyfriend.
- Q. Did you see the PEAKs again on Sunda y, 16 Aggust 1970? A. Yes, I see n Duane PEAK going over to the NORRIS's about 2330.
